Job Description

Level 3 Veterinary Assistants provide valuable support to Veterinarians and Veterinary Technicians in all services at Mission, including Appointments, Urgent Care, Surgery and High-Quality High-Volume Spay/Neuter. We offer an extensive onboarding program, with the goal of ensuring a new hire has sufficient time to gain the skills necessary to thrive in our fast-paced veterinary medical hospital. Job Details:

- Full-time, non-exempt (hourly), benefits-eligible
- Hourly rate: \$17-19/hour, DOE
- Schedule: 4, 10-hour shifts/week or 3, 13-hour shifts/week, including 2 weekends every 6 weeks
- Benefits: health insurance, 401(k), pet care discount, professional development

Responsibilities:

This person will work closely with all of our services, including Appointments, Urgent Care, Surgery and High-Quality High-Volume Spay/Neuter. They will provide valuable support to both technicians and veterinarians. Duties may include:

- General patient monitoring and care
- Assisting Technicians with restraint for medical procedures
- Taking patient histories
- Running lab work
- Filling prescription medications
- Preparing exam room, treatment room or surgical suite for each patient visit
- Performing radiographs, including patient positioning and restraint
- Patient surgical preparation and recovery
- Cleaning and packing surgical instruments
- Assisting with discharges and client education



- Performing basic blood draws and placing IV catheters
- Interpretation of ear cytologies
- Performing injections, including but not limited to vaccines, SQ, IM or blocks for surgery

Qualifications:

- Previous work as a Veterinary Assistant, including experience performing responsibilities listed above, or equivalent experience, required
- Developed communication skills, professionalism, and ability to collaborate with a team
- Commitment to hospital core values of compassionate, accessible care
- High School Diploma or GED
- Ability to multi-task and work effectively with competing priorities
- Ability to communicate clearly and respectfully with a diverse population
- Ability to remain composed under pressure in a fast-paced environment
- Must be able to lift over 50 pounds and stand for long periods of time
- Comfort with animals in a hospital setting
