

Veterinary Assistant

The Veterinary Assistant position operates in the main hospital services including Appointments, Urgent Care and General Practice Surgery. The Assistant supports Veterinary Technicians and Veterinarians in providing quality care to clients of all backgrounds.

Job Details:

- Full-time, non-exempt (hourly), benefits-eligible
- Schedule: 4, 10-hour shifts per week, including 2 out of every 6 weekends (both Saturday and Sunday):
- Benefits: health insurance, dental insurance, vision insurance, 401(k), pet care discount, professional development

Responsibilities:

This person will work closely with all of our services (appointments, urgent care, and surgery) and provide valuable support to both technicians and veterinarians. Duties may include:

- Cleaning and packing instruments
- Preparing surgical suite/exam room for each patient visit
- General patient monitoring and care
- Assisting with discharges and client communication
- Running lab work
- Surgery prep and surgery recovery
- Assisting technicians with restraint and patient monitoring
- Sampling as directed by technicians
- Taking patient histories
- Rooming clients/pets
- Vaccine injections

Qualifications:

- Familiarity/experience with veterinary medicine and general instrumentation preferred
- Developed communication skills, professionalism, and ability to collaborate with a team

- High School Diploma or GED
- Ability to multi-task and work effectively with competing priorities

- Ability to remain composed under pressure in a fast-paced environment
